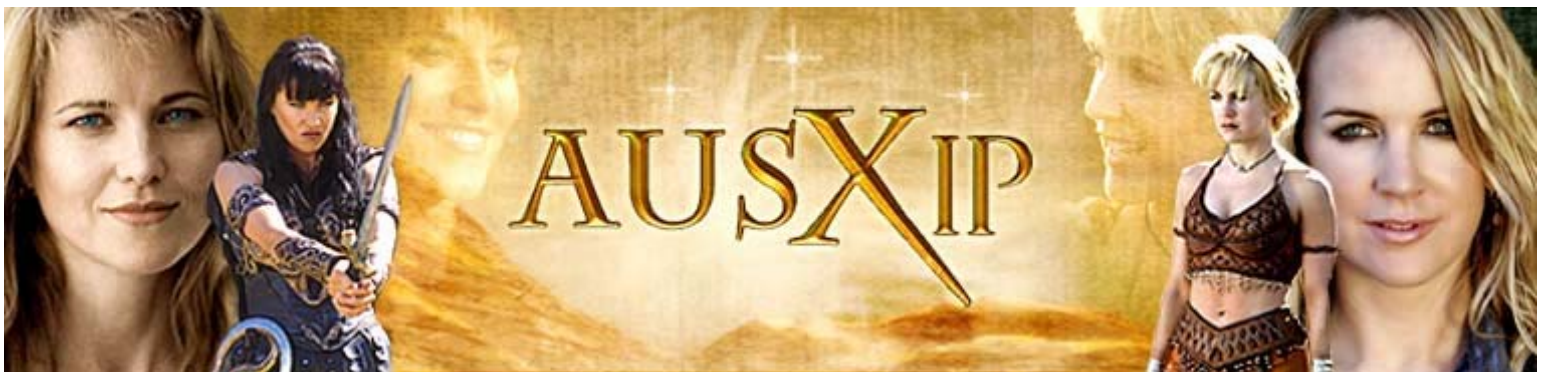

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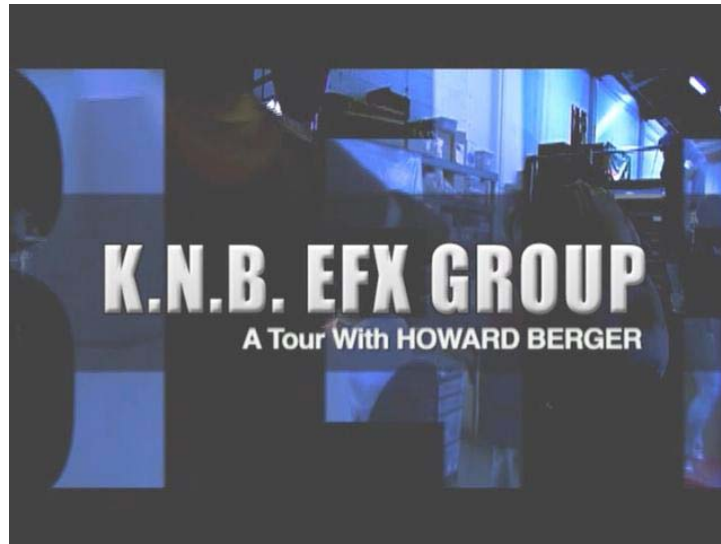
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“Bringing Monsters to Life” Xena Warrior Princess Part 2



I was compelled to feature the making of monsters to accentuate how important the creatures were due to the huge role they played in the story lines throughout the Hercules and Xena series. I also wanted to honor the production process that was extremely meticulous and executed by a very talented crew. The drawings, appliances and monsters shown in this article are during actual production in the design studio presented by Howard Berger, the on set supervisor at the time for K. N. B. EFX Group, Inc. in Van Nuys, California. Howard is now an Academy Award winning makeup artist 2006, winning an Oscar for THE CHRONICLES OF NARNIA. It was one of the greatest times and moments of his life. Howard currently co / owns KNB EFX GROUP, Inc. with business partner Greg Nicotero.

Part 2 will feature monsters seen in Xena Warrior Princess episodes. Hold onto you seats for this next exciting segment!

We don't normally see original drawings or maquettes that were used in actual production of Hercules and Xena in private collections. I was able to contact Howard Berger directly and he said the drawings were still archived in his possession and not discarded, as I had feared. Typically the large set used monsters were either left in New Zealand, fell apart or were torn apart to be some other creature.

Here are the mechanical cable operated arms seen in X 4 E 16 “The Way”. Indrajit was played by Rajneel Singh and Lucy Lawless as Kali.

Indrajit and Kali Test fitting with mechanical arms under development called a slave mechanism. Whenever Al the technician lifts up his arms the arms on the body duplicates the same movement. It actually took 3 people to operate Indajit. You can see the breaks at the wrist where they could remove and add different hands, open hands, closed hands, hands to hold various swords and weapons. The wrist band jewelry covered the breaks during filming.



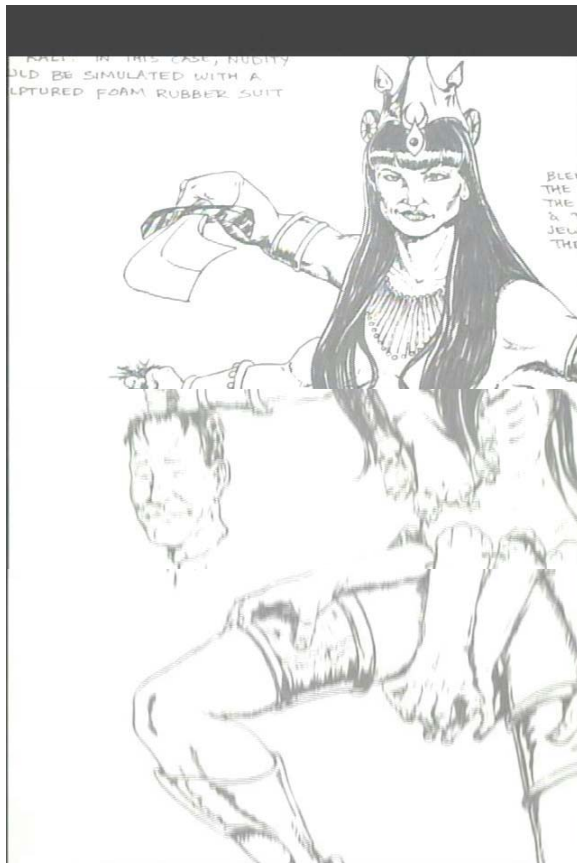
Raj’s costume as Indrajit weighed about 60 pounds, Lucy’s was about 30 pounds so they were really good sports about the heavy and tireless process and never complained. You can see the cables behind Lucy as Kali and Indrajit that moved the mechanical arms and the track she was standing on to slide her up to indrajit.

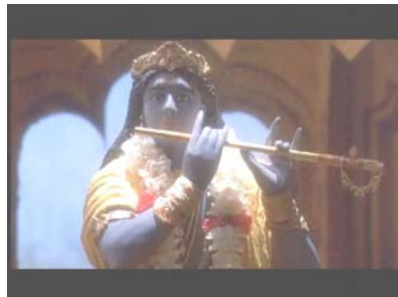
Conceptual Drawing of Character Kali

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This is Jake McKinnon who played character Hanuman the superman of the Indian culture he can do everything superman can do and his only weakness is Indrajit. The extras on the set were dying to be near him because he was so real to them.



Destroyer Monster

Mark Vinello who plays the monster is on the leg stilts testing them out. They were made of fiber resin so they were really lightweight. Howard says the make-up artists are best at playing the monsters rather than stunt men because they design monsters, they live monsters and at heart they can become the monster.



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You can see Al using the radio controller to manipulate the eye blinks, lips and nose with servos. Alex Diaz designed and sculpted the head.

Al putting on the urethane foam hooves the devil character wore flying below. Xena’s stunt double named Pauli wearing test Devil make-up below and there was also Zoe Bell as Lucy’ stunt double. Howard says there were Xena Demons everywhere on the set.



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Even though most of the episode was done with CGI the wings, hooves and other attachments were created as a point of reference for filming. The wings slipped into receptacles on the back to allow for wing movement. Xena below dressed as the devil. They used latex attachments on the face for translucency creating the best effect. The demon wings were very bat like with a membrane made with spandex nylon stocking. It was stretched across, glued down, spray coated a few layers with latex, then airbrushed to give the membrane transparency. KNB made about 7 or 8 pairs each of the white wings, demon wings and archangel wings. Howard has a pair of each sitting in storage currently. He thinks many of the others fell apart but we know of at least one in a private collection seen below. Does anyone else have a pair?



Here are a pair of test wings you can see the poles on the tips that moved them. The girls making the wings had to hand lay every single feather. They had to find all the feathers and most of them were turkey feathers that they bleached out.



Below you can see stunt Zoe Bell flying with wires and a harness practicing her moves. You can see Howard Berger manipulating the wings with a pole simulating the flying movements. The harness cables would cause damage to the feathers creating constant repairs that made the process a very arduous task. They then tried to steam the feathers down so they did not have any sticking up.

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Grindhilda Monster

from the X6 E 7,8 “The Rheingold” and “The Ring” Roger Morrissey plays the monster at 7 ft 4 inches tall, the monster actually stood 9 feet tall. There was the baby Grindl that was easier to make and deal with. KNB literally had 2 weeks to put the costume together and pieces would keep falling off due to the precarious construction. Also because of the fighting scenes the costume ended up in many pieces so the actual costume no longer exists, bummer!

Howard said that mermaids are very hard to do because they have to be in the water, they have to be on people, they have to be functional and aesthetically pleasing. They did a body cast and sculpted the fiberglass forms, you can see below the scales have been hand cut one by one into the sculpture. There are different materials that can be used to make the mermaid such as Silicone, Urethane and foam rubber. They chose foam rubber that had pros and cons but it was easy to glue down and easy to maintain. Even though it absorbed water they were able to squish the water out between takes.

Baby Roe had blinks, eye movement, brow and lip movement it could smile and frown and also had the tentacle movement. The crest of the head could also flip back and forth. This was a very well made and unique character. The movements were very real and intricate but Howard felt they were not all utilized to the full extent in the episode or the scenes that made the edit.

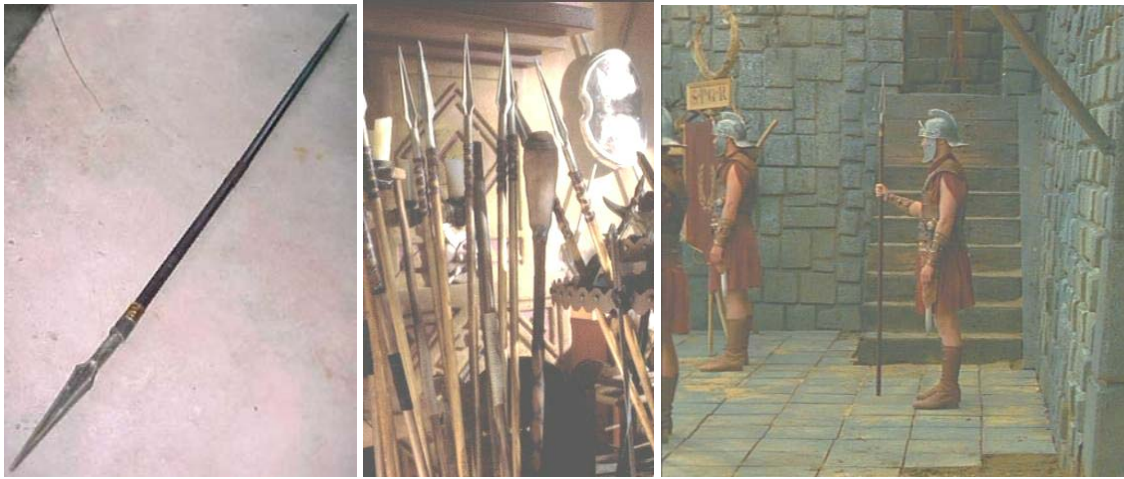

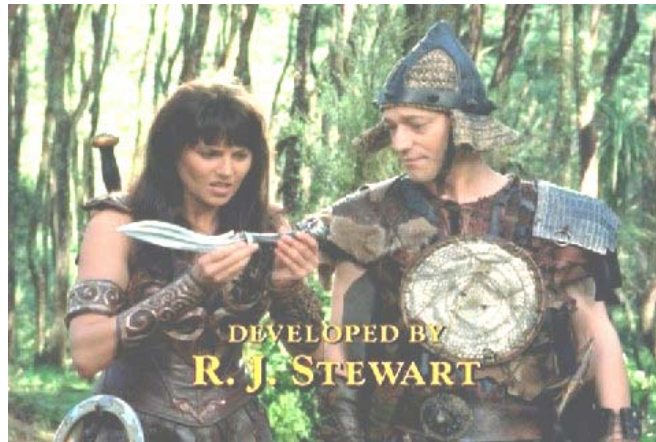


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Screen Capture from X 6 E 19 "Many Happy Returns"

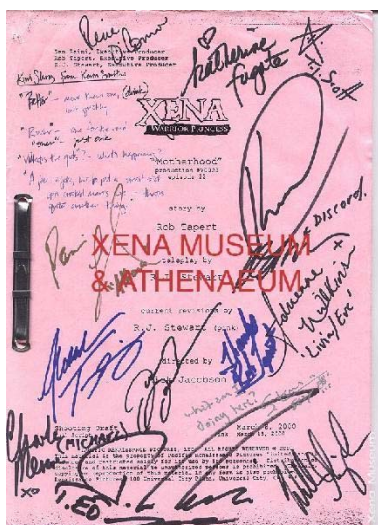

It has numerous handwritten notes by Alexandra regarding her performance and the production, and also includes her personal notes of Kiwi slang translations from Kevin Smith which she states on her website she was compiling in a notebook for herself. This script has also been autographed over the years by Alexandra, Lucy, Renee, Kevin, as well as by Rob Tapert, Ted Raimi, Adrienne Wilkinson, William Gregory Lee, Paris Jefferson, Meighan Desmond, Charles Measure, Steven Sears, Katherine Fugate, and TJ Scott. This script is given added provenance by extensive amounts of background information and photographs.

2. Original set used concept costume sketch/directions/model sheet of Xena's demon costume from the episode Fallen Angel. Added to the Xena Museum which already houses the screen used Demon costume worn by Lucy Lawless, it is especially educational to see how things changed from concept to final production. Although this sketch is a color copy, it is of the type used on set for circulation to the wardrobe team. There would have been only one original pencil sketch, typically accompanied by fabric swatches for the costume, and most likely retained by the designer. From that one original, multiple copies would have been made in color for distribution to the team during wardrobe production. Most of these copies were destroyed/discarded but a few were salvaged. There have been copies made after production ceased and they are in the market so it is necessary to have experience with these in order to assure authenticity based upon certain characteristics such as the type of paper used on set.

This book took many months to finish. It was a binding of a fan fiction story; L.J. Maas' Conqueror Series. This was a LONG story and a huge book. Part of what took so long was that I did all the layout & printing of the interior pages as well. Each of the three sections had its own title page that I had translated into Greek! The cover and box are full of symbols relating to the story. The box has stamped images of Greek warships and the capital of a Greek column. The book has a raised rosebud under the leather on the back and the front has the title of each section stamped on a white leather scroll with silver-leafed hand-carved wooden scroll ends. There were just so many details to this book. Even the page size was longer and thinner to help echo the long thin shape of a scroll. It took forever, but it is so monumental in size, I really like it. It's about 4 inches thick! I enjoyed the story too. Though rather shockingly sexual at first, to me, this is the "real" Xena. And LJ's description of the Amazon village makes you want to go live there!

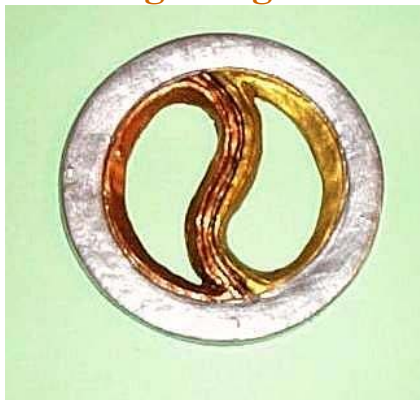

**Looking for that special little gift for your Xena friends?
Here are some charming polymer clay items by *Velda***

Interesting description of her process

After kneading the polymer clay I place it through a pasta machine. This helps to condition the clay, and gives me a nice even surface to work from. Each piece is hand made, no moulds involved at all so no two items are quite the same. I use a card template for the Sword & Sais, to give me the basic shape.



For the others I usually trace the picture straight onto the clay as these have a little more detail to them. Once I have a full tray of approx. 8 or 9 items, I then paint them. For the bladed items & Chakrams, I use two layers of paint, as the silver, gold & bronze metallic paints are quite transparent. Once the paint is dry, I then add the Swarovski crystals, as the inlays for the Chakram, Sword & Scabbard. All items are then cooked for approx 30 minutes. Once everything has cooled down, I sand off any rough edges, and give them another coat of paint if they need it.

Then it's time to paint the underside of each item, when all painting is finished & dry, I

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glaze/varnish each item. Then comes all the leatherwork, & finally I add the tiny Neodymium magnets, which are pretty powerful for their size. Each item is signed by myself and I will be making 100 of each. That item will then be retired. There are a few other things I do to create these magnets, but I don't want to give away all my secrets.
