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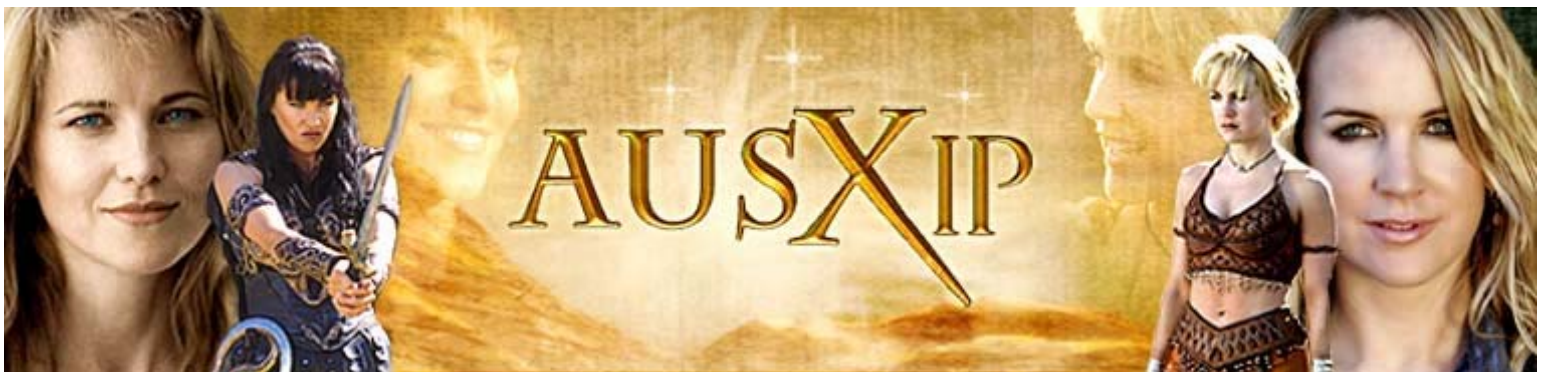

The inception of Xena Prop House is based on a passion for discovery and joy in collecting Xena and Hercules weaponry, wardrobe, production and set dressing items. Collecting props has quickly grown between faithful Xena and Hercules fans and we would like to challenge you to enter into our world of prop collecting. We welcome you to collaborate with our forum, contribute your personal collecting experiences and your knowledge of props, thus creating the ties that bind us together.

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The Hard Facts of Rubber and Foam Props

As we know metal is the most desirable material used for making props, timeless and bold in all of it's shining glory, usually made for close-up shots. The resin comes into a solid second place also very durable with a formidable shelf life. The foam and rubber are struggling for third place so lets see how bronze rates.

Rubber

The rubber props were clearly the best choice for actor safety on the set due to the flexibility like this scene below where a rubber dagger is used. Foam could crack or snap under any type of pressure and cause discomfort to the actor so we do not normally see those used in this case. Here is an example of a dagger on Xena's throat in X 2 E 11 "Here She Comes..... Miss Amphipolis". You can see the very tip of the rubber dagger bending at her throat under her hair. Since rubber daggers actually can touch the skin without harm they are desirable in the sense that they more often than not are materials that made contact with the hero or main actors skin. Special close-up scenes requiring the harder materials for shine or visual effects taken with great care may have also been used.



Does anyone have this dagger?

The down side of rubber is that it will deteriorate or crack over a period of time but with proper care you can help extend the life. A small investment should be made to keep them protected under glass or in a Plexiglas type container to protect them from dust that causes a tacky surface. Place in a room with a

regulated cool temperature for moisture to prevent drying between 70 and 76 degrees. It has been proven that props made of any and all materials in an airtight container will break down. Sunlight is a props worst enemy so always store or display your props in the coolest darkest place in your home.

Rubber will loose its shape as seen below. This is my Talia (played by Alison Bruce) rubber dagger from X 5 E 4 "Animal Attraction" You can see the tip is permanently bent from the soft rubber material and lack of support to the tip.



Here is my X 5 E 22 "Motherhood" dagger same problem with the bent tip.



Foam

The Urethane foam can be made flexible or rigid and is just as fragile and unstable if not more than rubber. Foam swords do have metal rod reinforcement in the center but leaning a foam sword against a wall or putting any stress points on it in any way is not recommended. Lying down on a soft surface or in a scabbard hanging on a wall or mannequin shoulder will eliminate any major pressure points.

Mixing a number of chemicals and adding a "gassing agent" producing bubbles that make the plastic cellular foam. Foamed plastics are heated from within- the heat comes from the chemical reaction causing it to raise. Eventually foam will deteriorate and crumble, a fact of life. So please consider this when purchasing foam. Oils on our hands aide in the breakdown of foam and rubber materials so handling is not recommended, If you must handle the props wear gloves.

Most foam props and blades are combined with a resin handle or base for stability. To date I have not seen a full metal dagger but know that they made resin that was electroplated. All you have to do is tap the blade and you can tell right away what is metal and what is coated resin.

The Black Wolf says, *“Some of the daggers were electroplated, we did make aluminum daggers for Xena, but they would be rare”.*



If you have seen or own an aluminum metal dagger please let me know I would like to feature it. I currently own 1 foam sword, 2 rubber daggers and numerous resin and metal swords. So I do think that it is good to have at least one of each type material to round out a collection.

Varia wore this belt in all her episodes except the Amazon ring fight scene with Gabby. It is very well made out of leather, bone wheel beads, bone/antler beads, horse hair and stone beads.

6. Waltraute' Valkyrie Armor Corset

Back shot with leave armor pulled away so you can see the lacing, there are 24 eyelets total..12 on each side.

The lifted leave armor is attached with velcro and leather ties. This corset is made of canvas and the leaves are all made of a soft rubber, the scales that you see when the leaves are lifted on the back appear to be done with a hot glue gun on the canvas itself.

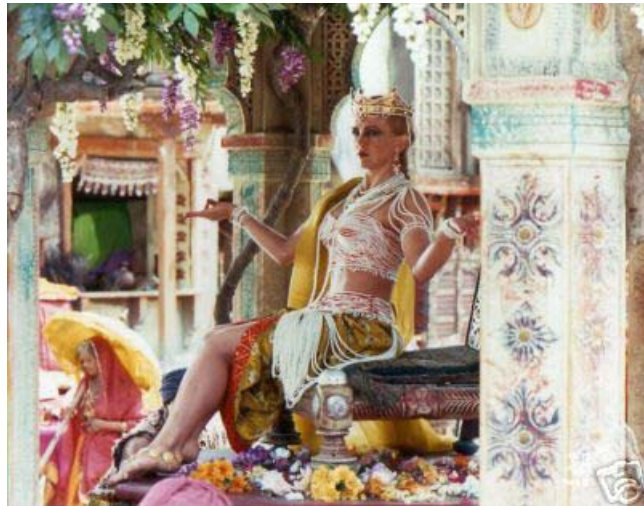
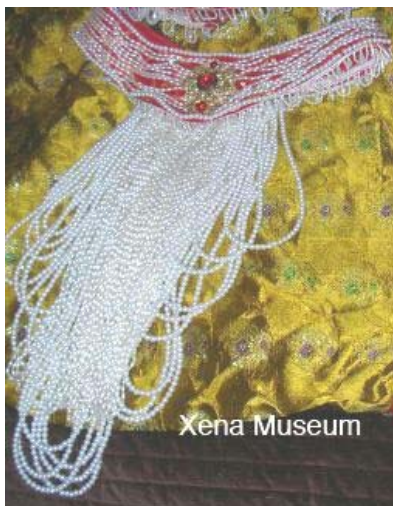

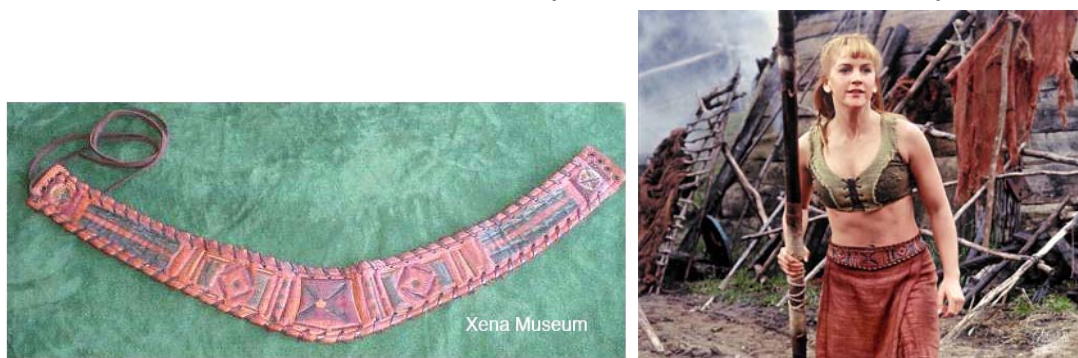

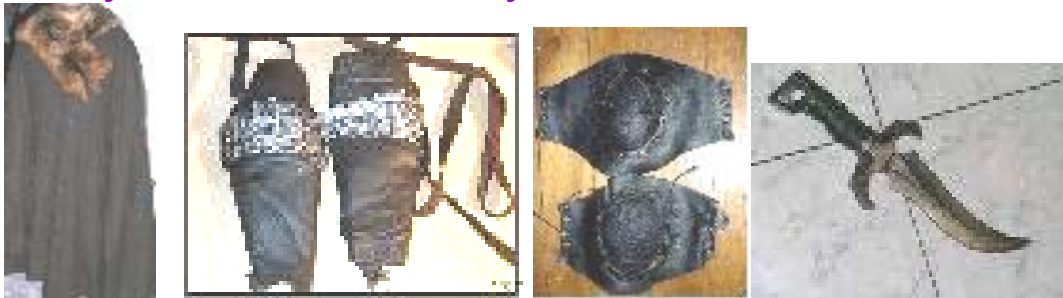

The screen capture from X 6 E 9 "The return of the Valkyrie" shows a stunt dress without the armor. Interesting you can see the actress is not Lucy but her stunt, looks like Zoe Bell, I blew up the pic and it is not Lucy!

Remember if a wardrobe does not have Lucy tags it does not mean that it wasn't hers but could be a stunt so keep this in mind. Lucy was taller than her stunts and doubles so this is a way to gauge the wardrobe especially if they are pants or a dress.

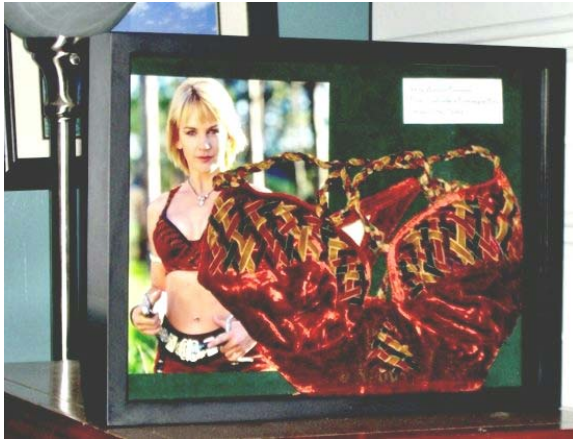

1. Gabrielle's prototype bra. A great piece, one of the prototypes the costume dept made on their way to her final look. It's pretty close. The backdrop is also material from her box of scraps for that outfit, and the prototype is displayed next to a picture of Gab wearing the bra. Inside the bra cup, the wardrobe dept wrote "Dud." LOL.
2. Gabrielle's costume material pieces from Old Ares had a Farm. This box is much smaller, so there wasn't a lot of room, but I managed to get scraps from each part of her costume-scarf, bra, skirt and they are displayed next to a picture of Gab in the outfit.

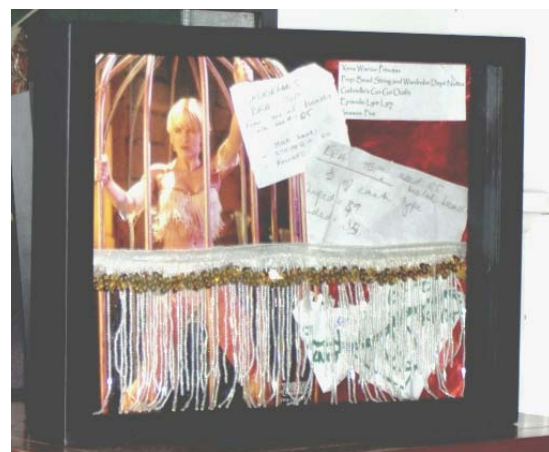


3. Here is Xena's Coffin Lid piece from The Quest. The back piece of the box is covered in fabric scraps from Gabrielle's sixth season outfit, so even the background is made from a set item. The coffin piece is attached as well with two photographs of the coffin that I printed as screenshots. I wanted one full view of the whole coffin and one closer up. I like that there are people in both shots because it ties the display together with the show. The COA from Turners is in there, showing the itemization of the coffin piece, and I made a nameplate that gives the prop name, the episode it's from and the season.

This shadow box contains a long beaded strand of Gab's go-go outfit and a set of handwritten notes by the prop dept regarding assembly of the bra with the bead pieces, such as bead count, length, etc. The strand is displayed over a picture of Gab wearing the outfit from Lyre Lyre, and I was really excited to find that I had a large enough piece of red velvet scrap from her 6th season outfit to put as a background on this one.

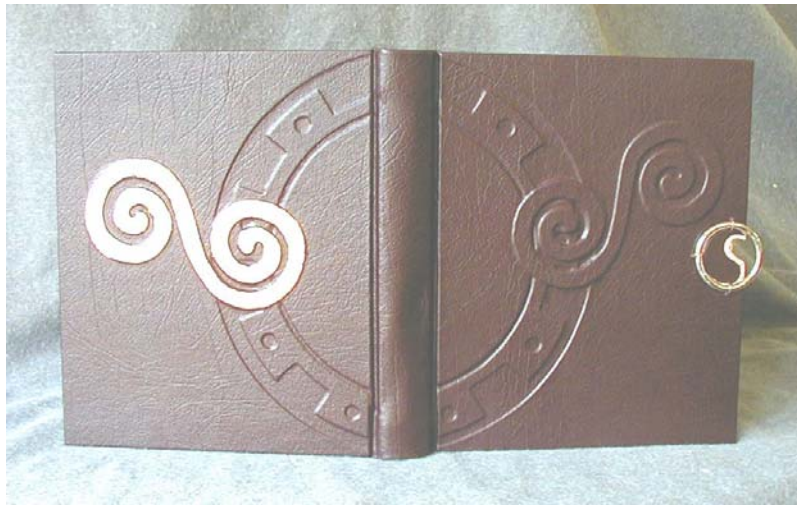

I made 3 or 4 of these blank Xena journals and wanted to do a book that played off Xena's swirl design on her armbands. I initially wanted to make the swirls out of the front swirl done in copper too. My initial design had only the back swirl done in copper so as not to detract from the detail on the front cover. The front cover has one of the real rings used on Lucy's Xena main hero costume and the dark brown part of the yin-yang design was covered with leather used to make her real costume bodice.

Looking for that special little gift for your Xena friends?

Here are some charming polymer clay items by Velda

Interesting description of her process

After kneading the polymer clay I place it through a pasta machine. This helps to condition the clay, and gives me a nice even surface to work from. Each piece is hand made, no moulds

involved at all so no two items are quite the same. I use a card template for the Sword & Sais, to give me the basic shape.



For the others I usually trace the picture straight onto the clay as these have a little more detail to them. Once I have a full tray of approx. 8 or 9 items, I then paint them. For the bladed items & Chakrams, I use two layers of paint, as the silver, gold & bronze metallic paints are quite transparent. Once the paint is dry, I then add the Swarovski crystals, as the inlays for the Chakram, Sword & Scabbard. All items are then cooked for approx 30 minutes. Once everything has cooled down, I sand off any rough edges, and give them another coat of paint if they need it.

Then it's time to paint the underside of each item, when all painting is finished & dry, I glaze/varnish each item. Then comes all the leatherwork, & finally I add the tiny Neodymium magnets, which are pretty powerful for their size. Each item is signed by myself and I will be making 100 of each. That item will then be retired. There are a few other things I do to create these magnets, but I don't want to give away all my secrets.

By making them at my own pace, and selling them on e bay I'm not letting you wonderful Xena fans down.
