





Packing/Shipping Etiquette...Do You Value Your Customers?

I have to ask myself this question every time a packing horror story comes to my attention. To me and many "Entertainment Memorabilia Collectors" my prop/wardrobe/autograph collection is as precious to me as the one ring was to Gollum. So when I see and read these horror stories considering the way some items I received arrived I felt more than compelled to write about this problem.

So why do these situations occur? Does the seller care about their customers? Does the seller care about what they are actually selling? Is it just the money or in the case of collectors gone seller is it that once sold and the money is in the bank these sellers don't care one way or the other whether an item arrives safely since the item is no longer theirs to care about. For the most part online dealers know how and do pack very well. However, not all of them do nor do many sellers on or off eBay.

Then there are the shippers, USPS, UPS, FedEx etc. I must say that any time I received an item packed by UPS or FedEx it arrived in perfect condition including my staff of Zarathustra which is over 6' tall...However how do they handle a package once it leaves the hands of the seller then the USPS/UPS/FedEx store clerk? Not to mention a countries customs department that may or may not open the box. Let me then relate a lovely Christmas story and UPS...

Twas four nights before Christmas and walking down the street was the hustle and bustle this season will bring. The night was so nice I thought to myself I will go out right now and bring some tasty sprits home with myself. So I in my jeans, shirt, and red cap decided to cut through the alley to make it that fast. When all of a sudden there arose such a clatter that I turned around to see what was the matter. There in the lights of the UPS shops' back door were two UPS drivers picking up Christmas packages with no cheer. The packages were stacked around 8 feet from the door and the truck itself was about 4 feet more. Then one of the drivers picked up a nice sized package and with a swing of his arms sent it sailing away through the air. The second driver caught it in the blink of an eye but missed the second, third and forth and they tumbled right by. This behavior continued till the truck was packed full then the drives hopped in and buckled up to go. As they started up and began to drive away "Merry Christmas" they said, "Mike, have a great night!"

Needless to say I was floored at the thought of what was in some of those packages that fell on the ground and some fell pretty hard, were the items even still in one piece? I immediately thought about future items I would purchase. I should have realized that the drivers/warehouse workers working for the shipping kings don't care about how a package is handled once packed and in their hands. To me their attitude is "I did my 40+ hours now give me my paycheck!!! Be damned if its insured" So it is IMPERATVE that all sellers/dealers use the utmost care in packing items for your customers. If you do not want to do it yourself due to lack of time, supplies etc. then let the folks who work for UPS/FedEx pack it for you...You must as a seller/dealer pack these items as if they were a precious piece of your own and you would assuredly pack it properly if it was...

Here are a few examples of packing/shipping issues:

Prop: Amazon Mask from Xena w/Renaissance pictures paperwork recipient Barbie Arms:


Problem: New Zealand eBay seller used a thin box with shoddy packing that caused two tears/holes in the eyepiece circled in black. The box was caved in on the top, really bad shape looked like it had been opened (probably by Customs) packing was poor not enough packing peanuts around the item unless some was removed by the customs when they opened it.



Prop: Spear from Xena recipient Barbie Arms

Problem: eBay seller packed the spear in a narrow box; spear was covered with bubble wrap but not enough packing to reinforce the box resulting in cracked wood below the spear head.

Prop: Original Hero Ray Gun Prop from Buffy w/Fox COA...recipient Jason De Bord

Problem: Unfortunately turned out to be an eBay seller/scammer kicked off the Movie Prop Forums and also eBay several times using different ID's names. Good box for packing but shoddy interior packing that allowed the gun to bounce around inside the box and break.



You will note it is only ¼ or so full of packing peanuts circled in red and the gun is just plain broken.



Prop: Original prop sword from Xena with Renaissance Pictures paperwork recipient Morgan aka “Xenasbard”

Problem: New Zealand eBay seller was misinformed and believed there to have been a metal rod running through the sword which is the case with many but obviously not all...also the seller depended on a third party to pack and ship the sword. The third party not knowing/caring simply wrapped the sword in a single sheet of bubble wrap placed it in a box and let it go.

And now for the last and it happened to the Aphrodite bust I currently own...What happened did not happen to me but to the original US buyer. I will note that the US buyer I bought it from took great pains to pack the restored piece perfectly.

Prop: Original Aphrodite bust from Hercules, Xena, and Young Hercules

Problem: Buyer paid an overpriced packing company who failed to do their job using a thin box with shoddy packing materials resulting in an almost fully destroyed piece.

Now this story did indeed have a happy ending (well sort of happy) as thanks to Gloria Hamlin of Hamlin Restorations <http://www.hamlinrestoration.com/> the bust was lovingly returned to its original form....

In the end it is we collectors that are the ones that loose out when items are packed poorly whether we get our money back or not...these pieces of TV/movie history are in many cases totally destroyed with no hope of restoration due to the materials involved in the making of props.
ARE YOU LISTINING SELLERS/DEALERS!!!?

I have been fortunate thus far with the props I have received, however some of that fortune has been luck...several pieces bought by me from a collector gone temporary dealer were poorly packed and I was amazed they arrived intact.

Please everyone shipping any item; be courteous to your customer and do the job right. When it comes to props/wardrobe we are dealing with items that go from the hundreds of dollars to the thousands of dollars but the cost is of no matter the fact is pack your items like a brick because

the shipping giants HAVE NO MERCY on any box they receive whether it is marked fragile or not!!!

Packing 101

Props and wardrobe being as expensive as they are need special attention when packing. If you are packing ANY pieces for shipment, I give you the United States post office rule: **"If you can shake it, we can break it."** The following procedure takes time but they create an almost foolproof layer of protection around valuable items to be shipped.

A box is a box is a box, right? **NO!!!** Using the right box can make a big difference in the case of packing and unpacking, and in the safety of the items being shipped. Thick sturdy boxes are imperative for shipping props/wardrobe. For any item you need to ship no matter how well made the item is, you should find a box that most closely matches the size and shape of the packed shipment then for extra protection, place this inside a larger box with packing peanut filler in between the two layers.

For costumes be sure to use a waterproof box (many vintage clothing dealers prefer Tyvek boxes), as a wet box can cause inks on the label, box, or documents enclosed to run and damage clothing. For maximum protection, particularly for items which are to be stored, obtain an archival box and pack the garment in acid-free tissue paper. Leather items should be wrapped in craft or butchers' paper first then in the bubble wrap to protect against dew from heavy moisture in the air as leather "sweats" and the plastic bubble wrap against the leather may build moisture.

Paper props, documents, newspapers, photographs etc. should be lined on both sides with acid free paper and encased in heavy stock boards a least two inches around larger than the item on all sides. Tape the boards all the way around to totally seal the item so that no moisture may seep in. Now that you have a box and have followed the special above procedures what's next?

- 1) Wrap the piece in small-bubble wrap. If it is painted, wrap it in a layer of craft paper first to protect the finish.
- 2) Follow with a layer of large-bubble wrap.
- 3) Wrap the resulting parcel several times in stretch film, going in at least two different directions, unless shipping miniatures you will put pressure points on small and fragile parts. Use more bubble wrap and packing peanuts instead.
- 4) Choose a sturdy box (and yes I believe prop documents should be shipped in a box and NOT an envelope or padded mailer...would you ship the Declaration of Independence in an envelope or padded mailer?) with at least two inches of room on each side of your wrapped parcel. Seal the box bottom with two layers of tape on all sides.
- 5) Use sheets of Styrofoam cut to form dividers to line the top, bottom and sides of box.
- 6) Fill the bottom with a layer of Styrofoam packing peanuts. Put your wrapped parcel on top, and then fill with peanuts to the top. Use only enough peanuts to fill the space -- if you have to push down to get the box shut, remove some peanuts rather than put internal pressure on the box.
- 7) Seal the top completely all around it with two layers of tape. Label it "Fragile" with large black letters on more than one side.
- 8) Once packed, clearly write or type out the shipping label then tape the label down well completely covering it with clear tape, to prevent moisture from obscuring the information. For extra protection, include a copy of the shipping label inside the package as well. Another alternative to look into for small and medium pieces would be suspension/Korrvu® packing by the

folks over at [Sealed Air](#). Korrvu® packaging is a packaging product that uses a strong, highly resilient low-slip film to surround your products, protecting them from shock and vibration.

In conclusion all I have to say is **PLEASE** sellers/dealers treat you customers with the respect they deserve when packing props/wardrobe you are selling to them, your customers give you their money in good faith and you only do yourself a disservice by shoddy packing which will lead to complaints, insurance filings, and lost customers...

More Magnets



Here are some charming polymer clay items by *Velda*

Interesting description of her process

After kneading the polymer clay I place it through a pasta machine. This helps to condition the clay, and gives me a nice even surface to work from. Each piece is hand made, no moulds involved at all so no two items are quite the same. I use a card template for the Sword & Sais, to give me the basic shape.



For the others I usually trace the picture straight onto the clay as these have a little more detail to them. Once I have a full tray of approx. 8 or 9 items, I then paint them. For the bladed items & Chakrams, I use two layers of paint, as the silver, gold & bronze metallic paints are quite transparent. Once the paint is dry, I then add the Swarovski crystals, as the inlays for the Chakram, Sword & Scabbard. All items are then cooked for approx 30 minutes. Once everything has cooled down, I sand off any rough edges, and give them another coat of paint if they need it.

Then it's time to paint the underside of each item, when all painting is finished & dry, I glaze/varnish each item. Then comes all the leatherwork, & finally I add the tiny Neodymium magnets, which are pretty powerful for their size. Each item is signed by myself and I will be making 100 of each. That item will then be retired. There are a few other things I do to create these magnets, but I don't want to give away all my secrets.

By making them at my own pace, and selling them on e bay I'm not letting you wonderful Xena fans down.




