## Article



### Xena Collecting, What is your Price?

Jane Frank writes a great art-collecting column in the ezine Estronomicon. Jane's column, "The Artful Collector" features a lot of collecting wisdom from 40 years of personal experience collecting SF and Fantasy original art. Jane and Howard Frank have THE PREMIERE SF/F art collection anywhere and they are also a lot of fun to talk to, as I've found out meeting up with them at different WorldCons. Jane's column, while written about collecting original art, is relevant to the serious Xena collector. **-Chris Clogston-**

In an early column, Jane adds this quote:

"We are three-quarters obsessive, two-fifths eccentric, and one-third witless", as William Walden observed. This applies to the serious Xena collector as well, though I might tweak the fractions for the three qualities mentioned. Collecting, by its very nature, is an obsessive activity, and every collector exhibits a certain level of obsessiveness when it comes to seeking a particular item for their collection.

One of the biggest issues that a Xena collector has to navigate is the question of price: How much do you pay for an item? As so many wise collectors know, **value floats**. The value of an item at any given time is dependent on **"time, place, and the individuals involved"**, again quoted by Jane. The ultimate price

for any item is the one you and the seller have agreed upon. If the seller isn't desperate to sell, and the buyer isn't desperate to buy, you might come close to an actual Fair Market Price.

In the Xenaverse, we would need to add an additional theorem: prices obtained at charity auctions will never be Fair Market, but will always be inflated. This is how it should be at charity auctions. The driving force is the interest in participating in "The Greater Good." This is a stronger driving force than the tax-deductible incentive for charity donations -- I say this because most people participating in charity auctions are not in the position to take advantage of that particular tax strategy. Xena fans are intrinsically charitable; if you get 5 Xena fans together in one place, one of them will invariably ask, "when is the charity auction?"

An important point to reiterate is that CHARITY AUCTION PRICES ARE NOT FAIR MARKET VALUE. Remember, not only are charity auction results are inflated, they are intended to be so, to the benefit of the charity.

The priciest items to collect in the Xenaverse today are original art, original costumes, and original props. Reproductions of props and costumes fall into a second tier of price. Rare promotional materials and collector cards (especially those that are signed or have a bit of an original costume) fall into a rough third tier. Xena merchandise seems to be near the bottom in terms of pricing. But it's important to know that any item in any category can cross over into another one in terms of price. Why? BECAUSE VALUE FLOATS and this should be every Xena collector's mantra, repeat it often!

The Enzo outfit has a main dress, an outer dress and a little cape or shawl. The shawl is the only piece labeled. I had acquired the Deino outfit from Andrew Burch of NZ that puts 2 out of the 3 sisters back together again, would like to find the third red dress.

## Jack of All Trades X 4

1. Here is the Emilia outfit seen in episode 'X-Marquis the Spot' she plays a dominatrix... This outfit is the lead character worn by Angela Dotchin who played 'Emilia'. This outfit is labeled 'Emilia' and some pieces are labeled 'A. Dotchin' and came with a 'It's a Wrap' COA certificate. The outfit was sold as complete but did not come with the lace teddy, the feather boa or the whip and I added them to complete the look like in the screen cap, It is very well made with lots of leather, lace and faux zebra skin. The mask made of heavy black leather and is trimmed with black and white feathers, the top is your standard lace style corset with faux zebra and leather panels, the skirt tail is nice black layered leather, everything is trimmed in leather with lots of silver studs...

2. Here's another JOAT item seen in episode 'One.,Two,Three Give Me Lady Liberty' with a screencap. It is not labeled and these were a standard issue for several characters and leads. It is made of canvas and a thick type padding with a makers label ' Body Arm wear LTD' 'Made in New Zealand' and another label 'IRB' which I have been told is a athletic equipment maker in New Zealand. It came with a Pac/Ren Turner's auction receipt for COA, but the seller sold it to me as Cleopatra 2525 futuristic head gear which I later found not to be true.

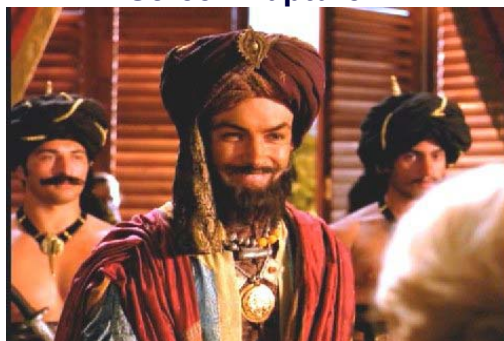


3 & 4 The next set of pics are from the JOAT episode 'Seventy Brides for One Brother'. These two items were worn by the henchman of the Indian Royal and they are very well made...the turban has cording made into to give it pizzazz with a metal ornament on top, it is a bit heavy to wear but very impressive. The necklace is made of metal and leather, I have seen many sold that were resin but many being heavy brass or copper. Both of these items have a Pac/Ren Turner's auction receipt for COA.

## Cleopatra 2525 X 7

1. Here is a cloak that Sarge (Victoria Pratt) wore in episode 'Home'. It is made out of a woven soft type of rattan material with a wide strip of short grassy horsehair looking/feeling material. It has a Pac/Ren Turner's auction receipt for COA.



2. The next 2 items are a set of heavy latex alien hands and a full thin latex mask from the episode 'The Watcher'. The gauntlets on the hands are made of soft foam. The hands are wearable; the head is a little delicate. These items were hard to get a screen cap of because it was background bar scene outfit pieces and shot mostly in the dark or in a crowd setting, but you can get a glimpse of it in the background of the screen capture below. Not a main character item, but wonderful enough it could be...They have a Pac/Ren Turners auction flyer and invoice for a receipt.

3. The next set of pics are mutant pieces.. from Cleo 2525 episode “The Voice”. The helmet is made of rubber metal material, tubing, window screening with a finned looking neckpiece to match the antenna looking pieces on the helmet, a long segmented tail piece that comes from the back of the helmet and hangs down to the waist...these outfit pieces are kind of hard to describe, but to me they look like mutant bug parts to me. The arm pieces are rubber bug looking segments with gloves. Also a set of greaves that look very much the same... they came from episode 'Noir or Never'. I don't have the main body armor, cod piece, boots or the tights to finish out the outfit..I bought these items in a boxed lot set from New Zealand. They do have the standard Pac/Ren Turners receipt as COA

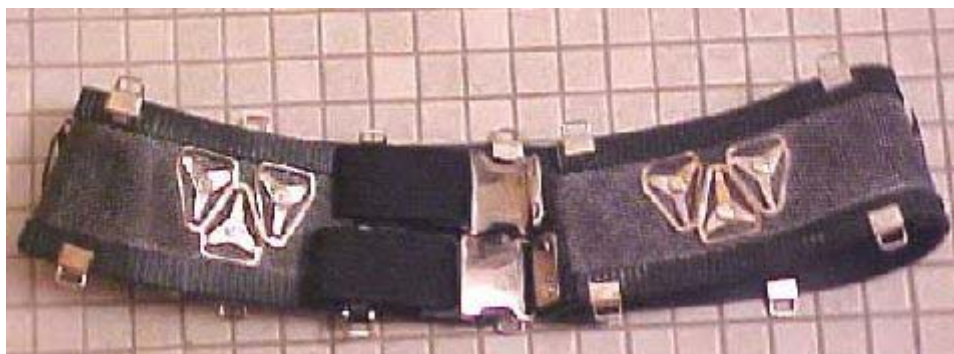

**4. and the last is just a standard issue belt made of rubber, leather and metal...it has a Pac/Ren Turners receipt for COA**





**5. This first outfit is from the pilot episode 'Quest for Power', it is a soft bandage looking sewn one piece skirt and top, medical ID bracelets, and shoes. It is labeled 'Cleo' on all pieces...but whether or not it's a hero outfit, I don't know.**

**6. This next outfit is from the episode 'Home' and is the outfit of the young Sarge (Rose) from the flashback scenes of her being a child and living on the outside. It is quite well made with a little wool round hat, material pants, top and shoes. All of the accessories are made out of a soft weave type of rattan grass-I guess you'd call it. It is labeled 'Rose' on all pieces and has a Pac/Ren Turners auction invoice for COA.**

**7. This next outfit is one of my favorites, I guess because it fits and I can wear the whole outfit, as with some of the outfits you buy don't even fit. It is from the episode 'No Thanks for Memories' and is the character 'Dylan' who was borderline of being a good/bad guy and is labeled on almost all the pieces. It is very very well made, the overcoat is heavy leather with tons of heavy metal adornment, thick padding on the shoulders and has a fishnet shirt underneath, the pants are padded/quilted and the boots have a space age look to them. It has leather, metal and material gauntlets and belt, gloves, padded elbow pads, 2 rings and a necklace. It has a Pac/Ren Turners auction receipt and catalog for COA. The gun is made of a closed cell foam coated in resin and painted, very much like the weapons/props made in Hercules and Xena.**

Having watched the It's A Wrap-Yahoo auctions obsessively, Mark recalls seeing the Prince Hercules cossie selling, minus the boots. It wasn't until the It's A Wrap warehouse sale (post auctions) that he found the boots in a big container of various boots/shoes. The boots were mostly shipped in separate containers, which may explain why many cossies were sold without their respective footwear.

The boots are practically mint, so Patrick must not have had much action in that episode. The two boots are tied together and the studio tag reads "Prince Herc" and labels inside both boots have Patrick Kake's name. Watching the episode you'll see these are definitely the boots for the costume, they are black leather and lace up the sides rather than the front.

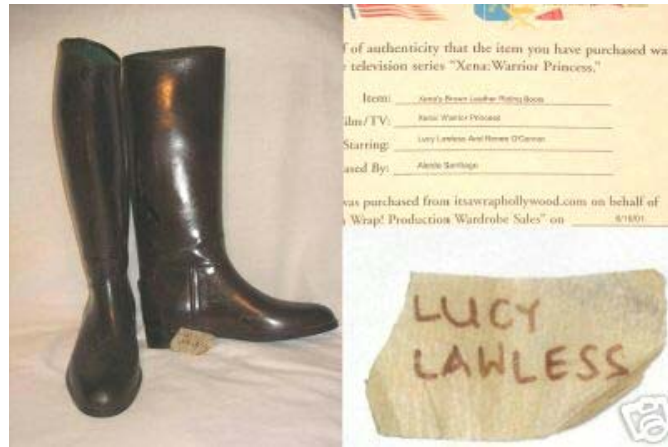

*"There were 7 working sets of armour at all times, 3 hard, 4 soft. The hard was copper, used for closeups etc. The soft was polyshield/plastic/latex. They needed to be soft for comfort and safety during stunts, and were used on Lucy, and the various doubles. It depended on the shot as to who wore what set or armour. I didnt make the actual armour for the Xena character, there were a succession of jewellers who had made many sets before I started working there, I maintained and repaired it, which was often."*
