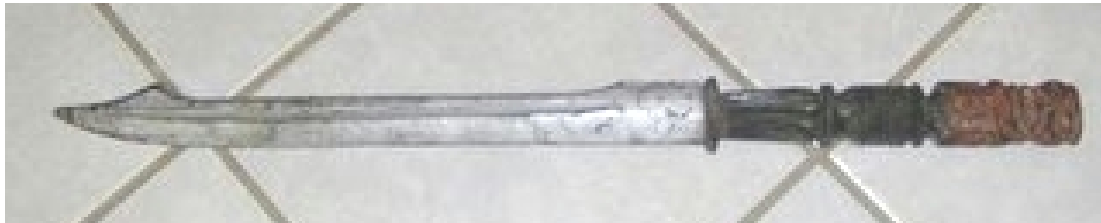

This is a very neat, well made sword; nicely cast in heavy rubber although some of the hilt feels like it might have had a resin overlay at one point, particularly the top of the hilt. Its ornately carved tiki design is very unique. This sword has quite a bit of wear and tear from use on the set but is still in pretty good shape. 1. Katana and Sheath

This katana is the same style used in XWP season 6 episode 'A Friend in Need'.

The sword is made of molded hard resin and was probably used by stunt or background warriors because even the material look on the handle is same mold casting and not material wrapped. It is painted silver/gray on the blade, handle is painted black with gold looking diamonds, the guard is hard molded golden colored rubber with a dragon on it. The sheath is all leather, dark brown with black leather straps tied in a criss-cross fashion, it is made around a metal pipe and has a double heavy leather belt/sash hoop attachment at the top.

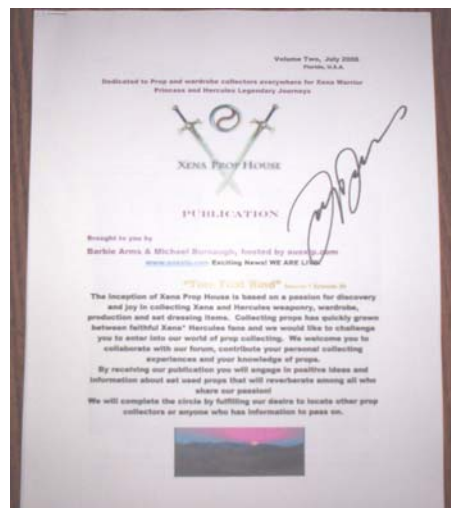

There are many stories about this first auction floating around the Xenaverse and a few people have given me photos they took of me going up to get it at the end of the auction -- and even though I didn't know these people at the time of that auction, several of them have become great friends. It was offered at Sunday's charity auction (Sunday was Xena day).; all of the money went to three local children's charities.

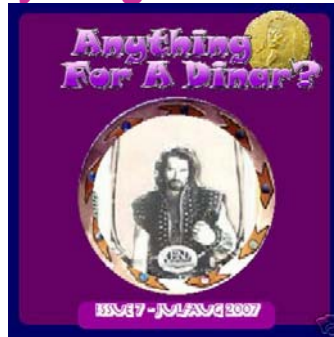

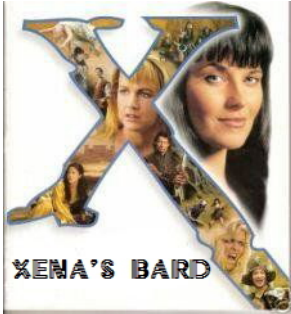

Audience: GASP!

Barbie: covers her face with her hands: EEEKKK! What have I done???

Howie: Gutsy move, Barbie! Don't worry though, there are still plenty of props left! Now, let's move on here before our models get irreversible leg cramps from standing up there so long! Pick a number, Barbie Arms of Ocala, Florida!!

Barbie: (looks towards Xena, who has taken a seat between Morgan and Mart). Mart is eyeing up her sword and Morgan is wondering how she is able to prevent split ends while riding at a full canter with her hair blowing in the wind. Barbie finally decides. Howie, I pick number FOUR!

Howie: Number Four, let's see what's in the box!

Number 4: It's.....Gabrielle's sixth season outfit!!! And umm.....well.....gee.....

Howie: (ducking as an amazon mask goes flying past his head) Well, folks, thank you for joining us this week on Prop or No Prop! It's certainly been an exciting episode and....OWWW!!...watch out for genuine set-used poison tipped arrows!!!! Medical! I need medical over here!

Xena: Sorry, Howie, I used the entire bottle of antidote in "One Against an Army." (looks fondly at Gab).

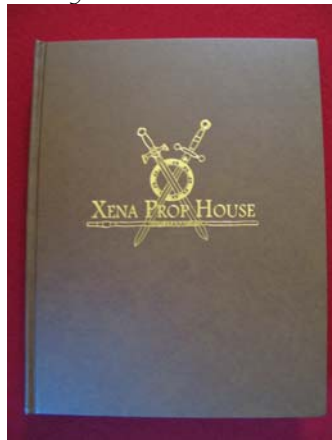
Howie: Even in poor ratings, Audience, I will never leave you!!! See you next week!!

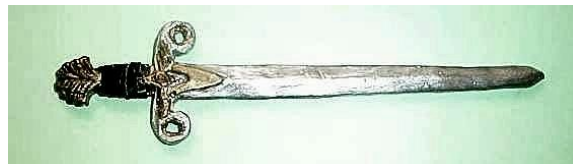

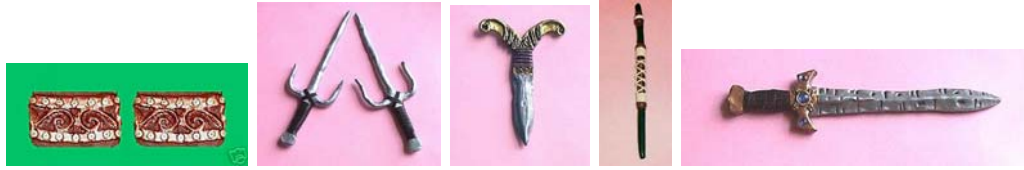
