Need to sell multiple Xena/Hercules Props and Wardrobe?

Lets have some fun selling on our terms without ebay fees and build our collections through other serious Xena and Hercules enthusiasts. We all need to sell items occasionally for various reasons so instead of dealing with the ebay rules and fees lets try selling among ourselves rendering a most satisfying and fun transaction for all.

We have all had a run in with unsavory sellers and buyers that lurk around on ebay so this will keep prop and wardrobe sales among our tight circle and we know they will be going to a good home!

You can run your own auction and Xena Prop House will announce the starting time and end of your auction with a comprehensive presentation of what you are selling then you set up the auction. The auction will be backed by XPH through assisting and referring readers and collectors to your designated auction time circulating your email and information throughout the duration of your auction. If you are a new reader and participant that I have never communicated with before and would like to announce your own auction no problem just give me one reference from a seasoned collector I can communicate with to verify your commitment to your auction before I can announce it. This is a great way to make quicker bulk sales but XPH will still keep **“A Day in the Life”** section for the casual individual sale items and for photo sales. I can announce multiple auctions so there is no need for a first come first serve basis.

GROUP MAILINGS

I can also do a group mailing with a general list of descriptions and prices of items you have for sale. Then you can sell them on a first come first serve basis to the collectors who respond to you. I have also done group mailings to let collectors know about items listed on ebay.

Contact Barbie at XPH and communicate that you would like to run an email auction or group mailing. Xena Prop House issues come out by the 15th of every month so you would need to make contact by the 7th of each month leaving time for the auction or group mailing to be worked up by me and announced in the issue. It would be suggested you start the auction or group mailing at least 4-7 days after the issue comes out on the 15th so readers have a chance to read

about your items for sale introduce themselves as a potential bidder or buyer and your preparation to start receiving offers or bids. I will help you through the entire process however if you choose an auction **you** will be running the auction keeping records of the bidding activity, etc.

ANNOUNCEMENT

SELLING ON AUCTION SITES

Those of you who have done, or still do use ebay for selling Xena items (or other things for that matter), will probably know about the recent changes to seller fee structures on ebay which particularly hit the small/medium-sized sellers of low price items. This is just the latest, but worst, in about 3 year's worth of changes that have gradually sucked more from the seller, and made life much more difficult and less profitable on the site. Along with droves of other former ebay sellers, I've closed down my small shop, and am moving to another auction site. This site has been voted the 'best alternative' - and can be found on ebid.net

On the plus side -

The seller fees are about the most reasonable you can find anywhere. They have a wide choice, and are currently offering a limited time, half-price lifetime seller+ membership - which means you only pay a basic shop/seller fee once. This lifetime one-off fee is currently the same as the one month fee for a mid-range ebay shop. After that, you can chose what fees you want to pay - from nothing at all (free auctions), upwards - depending on how pretty etc you want your listing to look (eg, extra photos cost just 3p each).

There are no basic listing fees, so if your item doesn't sell you don't lose anything.

They have a reward system (called buddy points), which you can accumulate to spend on certain items.

There are different options for your listings, which offer much greater flexibility to how you sell. Many items are cheaper here, as the fees are so much lower.

On the negative side -

This is currently a much smaller, much less-well-known site, and sales are much slower. Looking at the chat boards, it's apparent that the 'ebay refugees' are all working hard to promote it, and to encourage folks to use [ebid](http://ebid.net), rather than ebay for both selling and buying. Many think that [ebid](http://ebid.net) will be the site of the future - so do keep your eyes open! If you don't want to sell/trade your Xena items between friends or contacts, why not give this site a try? If you only buy - watch this site - it already has some interesting Xena collectibles on it, and this is likely to increase (I've got a few Xena props/items I'll be putting on in the not too distant future).

Please pass on the news to your other contacts - the more who know the better!







2. CHERISH COSTUME

For Sale is this beautiful Costume Xena wore as Cherish in episode 'A Royal Couple of Thieves' It comes with a hand signed letter of Lucy's along with the COA from IAW. This costume was originally purchased by Sharon Delaney and is priced at \$3000/obo as this comes with the letter and was Lucy's. This does not come with the armbands.





3. Livia Metal Sword

Adrienne used it in all her close ups, it is electroplated to be shiny for the camera and has the COA from IAW and was purchased from Anne Davidson asking \$1,675 OBO



4. Xena Stunt Boots

Here are Lucy's stunt boots and they come with the IAW COA showing that they are Lucy's with a label. Something else to be said about these boots- Lucy herself advertised these boots on her site stating them to be hers, as they were auctioned off for charity, along with quite a few other props and costumes of hers at the time. They are also her size so even though we know they aren't her hero boots, we know she obviously did some stunts on horseback, and these are equestrian boots. Lucy wore these English equestrian boots when she did limited stunt work on top of Tilly (Argo) the beautiful palomino mare she rode throughout the series. The boots are actually black painted brown to go with her brown leathers. They are a size 10 1/2 (her size) and are a rubber material not leather like her normal boots. \$150



5. Arch Angel Sword



“If The Shoe Fits”



Love the maps

This is a Q and A section to help get those important questions answered.

Q1 I recently purchased a dagger that I originally thought was a lighter weight resin, but on further examination, found that it is definitely coated in metal, or perhaps made of a very lightweight metal. It "sings" loudly when tapped against another metal object, whereas my resin daggers do not make this same melodic sound. It also feels like metal when you touch it, although it is painted gold over the metal parts and not "shiny" like you would expect metal to be. It is common knowledge and I believe verified by the Black Wolf (Roger) that the prop dept. used four different materials for their weapons: Foam, resin, rubber and metal. However, most metal weapons I have handled are definitely quite heavy. My dagger is clearly metal but not very heavy; in fact, not even as heavy as some of my resin daggers. Can anyone shed any light on what this may be made of or the process of electroplating? I thought in order to electroplate an item, the surface of the object to be electroplated also had to be metal for the charge to be conducted and

the process to succeed. The dagger's origins are 100 percent genuine and it is from the set (it is a Livia style dagger) but this is the first time I have owned a dagger made of this material. Any thoughts? **MORGAN**

Dear Friends

Firstly, and quick update on my dear dad – who you may remember was diagnosed with cancer a year ago. The chemotherapy was more successful than we could have hoped for – thank you all for your thoughts and prayers, I'm sure these had something to do with this! Unfortunately we haven't had as much of a delay as we had hoped, and he is now on another round of two types of chemo, as the tumors have flared up and are growing again. We know his cancer isn't curable, but hopefully this will buy us some more time. We won't know for another month or so whether it's having any effect – so keep fingers crossed please?? **Lilias Odell**

A question was asked – why do you collect props from Xena and Hercules TV show?

I'd like to share some thoughts and experiences with those who understand – so please bear with me.

The last 9 weeks have been something of a trial, and since 11 September, the days have been a serious struggle. I said to my dad a couple of weeks ago that I felt very lucky, as I always have something to turn to in times of trouble – just stick a dvd in the player, and instant therapy! I was a latecomer to Xena (the story behind that would fill a small tome all on its own), only discovering its magic late in 2002. I can't explain what the journey through the six seasons has meant – despite extensive self-analysis, it remains something of a mystery to me. Jane Goodall (of Chimp fame) once defined spirituality as 'awe of something outside yourself'. I view Xena with more than a degree of awe – maybe that offers some small, partial degree of explanation.

Life hasn't been exactly easy (though there's always someone worse off, there's a heck of a lot of folks better off!). I was blessed with wonderful parents and, although they had little money, they gave me a loving upbringing, and wonderful childhood. I have also been blessed with a half-decent brain – which was a darn good thing considering what was to come ...

I was cursed by a physical body which stopped working properly at the age of 12, and have faced a 36 year battle against constant physical and mental fatigue, then a 26 year battle against constant pain and greatly fluctuating levels of functionality. I often say that the only guarantee I have in life is that I can never guarantee that I will be upright in 30 minutes. Thus, life hasn't been what I would have chosen. I have been unable to do many of the things I wanted, and to add insult to injury, 15 years ago I discovered that it is highly likely that all this could have been prevented if appropriately treated at an early stage.

There is an immense array of emotions to deal with, along with the physical trials. I always try to monitor myself and do my best to control these, but as the years have passed, it has become harder and harder. Depression when going into one of my 'bad phases' was getting quite scary, and the anger was increasingly more akin to rage. This could be brought on by the smallest things (I remember once watching someone on TV

getting out of a car, and being overcome with fury that ‘normal’ people can do this sort of thing without thinking about it, while I have to concentrate on every single movement – firstly to *make* myself move, and secondly not to hurt myself when moving). You can get so tired of the fight, and will power can ebb away alarmingly quickly.

Then I found Xena. I have no idea why this connected so strongly with both conscious and subconscious, but I think the gods that with it came a renewed inner strength, and an emotional leveler.

I have faith (the ups and downs and adventures/explorations of this would fill a large tome). Many say that faith will see you through the hardest times, but I’ve seen and known people with the strongest faith struggle badly, and sometimes fail. Faith is intangible. Xena is tangible, and I have, personally, come to think of it as a gift from God. It is many things to many people, and that is one of its great beauties – it is what you need it to be, and it changes to meet your needs.

I’ve watched the entire series through from beginning to end 3 times (the last time was four years ago, at the beginning of a ‘bad phase’ which lasted many months). In between I pick different episodes for different situations – the ones I want have always popped easily into my mind. And yes, I also watch purely for pleasure! I go long stretches without watching any at all, but I know it’s there for me, and somehow inside me (bit spooky really).

Nine weeks ago, I descended into a ‘bad phase’ – couldn’t hold myself up and lost most of the use of my arms and hands. Hurt like Tartarus too!! It was about 4 weeks before things began to improve (interestingly, I didn’t turn to Xena during this time – I seem to need to view it less now for this sort of thing). Then, just over 5 weeks ago I decided to try out something completely different – and grew abscesses on 2 molars, which was a real barrel of laughs – but at least I didn’t feel my other pains for a while. Penicillin is a wonder, but I never had the chance to get the teeth sorted out, because on 11 September, dad phoned to say that mum was on her way to hospital in an emergency ambulance, as she’d suddenly developed acute chest pain. I met him at the hospital (takes about an hour for me to get there), and we sat with her (in between tests), and watched her agony, which was so great it kept making her wretch and writhe. After a couple of hours she was moved to a ward, and shortly after this the doctor came to tell us that they thought it was one of two things – severe chest infection (which they could treat), or ... and this was a big ‘or’ ... her aortic aneurysm was leaking, in which case there was nothing they could do except keep her comfortable. My big sister and her husband had arrived by then, so dad and sis went to sit with mum for a few minutes before they started treatment. Less than 10 minutes later my wonderful mum was gone. The aneurysm ruptured. In the end, she passed peacefully with her family around her.

For those of you who have lost a much-loved one, you understand the quite overwhelming pain, grief and shock. On top of this, I’ve had to deal with the considerable physical consequences – as I’ve discovered, the tension of loss creates great havoc in already evil muscles, and the constant pushing beyond normal physical limits take a very cruel toll.

When I finally returned home that night, I needed my Xena, but for the first time could not come up with any episode I wanted to watch. For two nights I slept poorly, with terrible, disturbing dreams of mum. Then, on the third day it came to me. I didn’t want

individual episodes or story arcs – I needed the whole lot. Out came Hercules – The Warrior Princess.

I was frankly completely gobsmacked by how quickly a sense of serenity crept in and took over. I was also gobsmacked (great old word that!), because rather than keeping me awake (normally I don't view too late at night as it gets my mind churning), it helped me fall asleep and, with one night's exception, there have been no more disturbing dreams. Last night I finished the journey, and it has been very different from previous ones. Someone once said to me it was 'escapism', but it isn't – I find it to be 'confrontism'. I have continued to mourn throughout, but with cleansing rather than corroding tears. I have continued to remember both the events of the day mum died, and my memories of her, but I have been able to do this without the gnawing, destructive pain – instead my thoughts and memories have been filled with love and thanksgiving.

Last night I watched FIN. I had agonized over whether or not to, since starting Season 6. In the end I felt the need to complete the journey, but in some ways I now wish I hadn't. I have always (since the first time), found FIN painful (it's one of my least-viewed episodes). Not because of the death of Xena – I never had a problem with that (except the grief of course), but because of the humungous philosophical YAXI – the reasoning behind 'I can't come back'. Watching FIN last night proved a completely different experience from before. There was no pain of expectation, and up to the last few minutes, I saw a beauty in it that I'd not seen before. However, the last couple of scenes were very different too – instead of anger at the betrayal of such a deeply imbedded philosophy, I became completely numb. The magic totally disappeared, leaving a curious nothingness. Xena episodes, unlike anything I've ever seen/heard/read before, never get 'old'. Thus, I did the only thing I could think of to bring back the magic ... Herc – The Warrior Princess. I'm about to do what I've never done before – watch the series through again straight away. I'm not ready yet to be without it. Though I may well make a few changes in the order/episodes watched, and will avoid FIN this time round.


One last, unexpected benefit. A couple of days after the funeral, my bloomin' abscesses flared up again with a vengeance. I spent much of the first day groaning around, but when I put my evening therapy into the dvd player, within 45 minutes the pain had eased enormously. (An hour after I stopped it came back again, then went off after a further dose – this went on all night – Xena, sleep for an hour, Xena, sleep for an hour etc etc!). I hadn't realized before that Xena was also an effective analgesic. Someone really ought to do a psychological study on all this! It is a bit ridiculous.

So, why do I collect Xena props? Because I want to have a little bit of that magic around me.



THE QUILL IS MIGHTIER



Here is a section that will be written and submitted by Morgan Summers every month. Her humorous wit is just too precious so please Enjoy!

The Dow-Jones is falling, the dollar is gasping for breath, and the economy is in quite a precarious position. I determined that this is both a great time, and a horrific time, to be a prop collector, but the problem is, I can't decide which point of view to embrace. It's been several years since the end of the Xena series, and as people balance their own personal budgets, downsize possessions, and attempt to pay off lingering debts, you see more and more props and costumes up for sale. However, as I try to balance my own personal budget, downsize my possessions, and attempt to pay off lingering debts, I have less and less to spend on these props that have suddenly made their way into the market. 
